notes:

consider this as an effective music notation but relate it to abstract painting form as well

to play this piece require a specific attitude from the performers

look to the chart/canvas as you look to abstract painting, let your eyes to tell you what to play -which part of the canvas your eyes are actually focusing on- let your ears to tell you how to play -the kind of sounds to produce- after a sound or sequence has been played, take a breath -silence- go on a different part of the chart/canvas and repeat the process untill the end of the piece

underterminate number of players

underterminate number of any kind of instruments & electronics

relative pitch/sound is graphed high, middle and low

any tone/sound within the range indicated may be sounded

limits of the ranges are freely chosen by the players, limits can be changed during performance

numbers indicates the amount of sounds to produce in a specific range & duration

each performer can play one up to the eights pages in any order, this will occurate differents times durations of the piece and sort of interactions as well

box durations are proportionally estimates by each performer in order to find a common sense of breath
